

APPENDIX A - MSA WORK ORDER STATEMENT OF WORK

This is a staff augmentation to acquire an additional SAP ABAP Development resource who is qualified to function as <u>SAP Performance and Stress Testing Specialist</u>, <u>Level III</u> as specified in the Scope of Services section, and will work closely with the ITD-BASE Team.

The successful provider must be able to furnish candidates who possess a combination of education, skills, and experience that commensurate with minimum requirements.

1. Scope of Services

The District seeks a firm that will perform the required work closely with LAUSD project team members and perform the responsibilities in the HP Load Runner and performance testing tool functions of:

- Developing automated test scripts, conditions, data, and expected results for performance test efforts.
- Executing tests and report results according to testing standards and procedures.

3. Assumptions

For the duration of the project, the selected resource **is expected to bring his/her own laptop computer equipped** with an appropriate operating system that can access the District's SAP system and other project management tools such as MS Word, XLS, SharePoint, etc.

4. Work location
