

Quick Start Guide to





Focus Reporting & Dashboards (Focus) is a web-based application that provides LAUSD administrators with dashboards and reports consisting of student and LAUSD data. This application allows users to see important metrics and other strategic data about LAUSD. Most metrics display target levels to determine if performance is on target. Access the Application

To access Focus, type this **URL** into the address bar of your browser:

https://focus.lausd.net

Note: The preferred browser is the latest version of **Google Chrome** or **Mozilla Firefox**.



Log into the application by entering your **Single Sign On username** (i.e., do not include @lausd.net) and **password**. Then, click **Sign In**.

Welcome Page

The Welcome Page is the first page users see when they log into the application. This page provides information about the application and displays all five **Analytic Areas**, which are the categories of data stored in Focus. Each Analytic Area displays all related **Subjects** to which the user has access. Navigate to a Subject to see all related dashboards and metrics. Refer to this page for a summary of the components of the Welcome Page.

Subject Page

The purpose of the Subject Page is to provide a list of all available dashboards within the Subject, as well as the related metrics to which users should pay attention.

Note: The Subject Page will only display dashboards to which you have access. For example, school users will only see Campus View dashboards.

7	In Job Aids & Videos, watch training videos or review job aids about this Subject.
8	Access the dashboards you visit most often in the Frequently Viewed Dashboards section. Click the arrows to scroll through the list. (Note: This section is updated nightly.)
9	Click the Home icon to return to the Welcome Page.



Navigational Bar

The navigational bar can be found on all Subject Pages and dashboards to make it easy to navigate between Subjects or dashboards within different Analytic Areas.



* On a Subject Page, click a Subject to navigate to the related Subject Page. On a dashboard, click a Subject to see available dashboards.

On a **Subject Page**, use the navigational bar to access another Subject.

1. To select a different Analytic Area, click the down arrow in the **Analytic Area drop-down menu** on the left side of the navigational bar.

1. To select a different Analytic Area, click the down arrow in the **Analytic Area drop-down menu** on the left side of the navigational bar.



2. Click an Analytic Area to reveal all of its Subjects.



3. Click a **Subject** to reveal all dashboards in that subject.

Job Aids & Videos

Job aids, videos, and other help content can be viewed and downloaded via the Welcome Page, Subject Page, and all dashboards.

On the **Welcome Page** and **Subject Pages**, the section displays content relevant to that page. To see all help content available in the application, click the **See All icon**.



To see all available content on any **dashboard**, 1) click **More Options** in the navigational bar, and then 2) click the **Job Aids icon**.



After clicking See All on the Welcome/Subject Pages or the Job Aids icon on a dashboard, use the **search bar** to find content on a specific topic.

Catalog

The catalog stores saved objects such as analyses and filters. The catalog can be accessed on every page in the application. There are two views available:

- 1. The **Basic View** is available on the Welcome Page, Subject Pages, and dashboards, and it can be used to quickly access a report or other saved items.
- 2. The **Composer View** is provided for Composer and Publisher users to access reports, filters, and other items in order to edit or delete them. The Composer View can be accessed within the Basic View.

To view the catalog in Basic View, click the **Catalog icon** on the Welcome Page, Subject Pages, or dashboards (in the navigational bar, click More Options > Catalog).



To access the Composer View, click the **Composer View icon**.

The key icons to know in the **dashboard toolbar** are the **Info icon**, which opens the related user manual when clicked, and the **Filter icon**, which displays all dashboard filters (expanded in the image below).

The key icons to know in the **component toolbars** are listed below. See the next page for a glossary of all icons in Focus.

Click the **Maximize icon** to view the component in full screen and then click Minimize to go back.



Click the **More Tools icon** and then choose **Print** to print a graph.



The **Filter icon** is available to filter the related component only. Filters will vary by component.

Icon Glossary

Focus displays many icons throughout the application, with the majority in toolbars. Each dashboard consists of multiple sets of toolbars. The **Dashboard Toolbar**, located at the top right corner of the screen, controls the entire dashboard, while the **Component Toolbars** throughout the dashboard control each component individually. In addition to the toolbars, the **Navigation Bar** contains icons to navigate to other screens. See the image below for an example, and refer to this section of the guide for definitions of all icons.
