JOB SAFETY ANALYSIS OPERATING AN A CARPET EXTRACTOR

General Precautions:

Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)*

Safety goggles, chemical resistant gloves

Required Training

Operation of carpet extractor and PPE

*Additional training and PPE may be required depending upon the scope of the activities to be performed. All construction areas must be demarcated and barricaded.



TASK	HAZARDS	CONTROLS
1. Equipment inspection		<p>Always unplug the machine prior to inspection.</p> <p>Ensure electrical cord is in good condition; not frayed or damaged.</p> <p>Ensure ground plug terminal is not broken off.</p> <p>Check to ensure the equipment is in good condition.</p>
2. Preparing for work		<p>Put on PPE</p> <p>Add water to tank prior to adding chemical solution.</p> <p>Be sure to replace caps on chemical concentrate containers and on the extractor.</p> <p>Plug machine into a GFCI.</p>
3. Operating equipment		<p>Ensure to maintain proper posture while operating the equipment.</p> <p>Be aware of tripping hazards from the electrical cord and hose.</p> <p>Only move the machine by the handles provided; do not pull on the hose.</p> <p>Maintain a balanced position when moving the equipment.</p> <p>Ensure to wear goggles and gloves when emptying the dirty solution.</p> <p>Only empty solution into a hopper room sink.</p>
